TRAINING & SUPERVISORY ACTIVITIES DURING January - December 2001 *

A. TRAINING

I. National TB programme (NTP)

- a) Two regular-training courses, each of 8 weeks duration were conducted during the year
- (i) The 85th training course on TB control of eight weeks duration for DTP key personnel was conducted at the Institute from 15th Jan 9th March 2001. In all, 54 trainees consisting of 19 MOs and 35 para medicals from different states of the country participated which included two from Nepal and four sponsored by the WHO. The breakup of trainees is given below:

They also underwent one-week modulartraining in Short Course Chemotherapy (SCC). The trainees accompanied by the NTI faculty and technical staff visited various centers in Tumkur, Ramnagara, Channapatna, Kanakapura, Devanahalli. Doddaballapur, Magadi and Anekal taluks in Bangalore rural, Bangalore urban and in Bangalore Mahasnagara Palike, for field training from 26th Feb -2nd March 2001. For the first time, patient interviews were included as part of the field training with the objective of improving the management and supervision skills of the trainees. For this purpose. patient interview schedules were developed to obtain information on diagnosis, treatment and follow-up. The NTI faculty reviewed the field reports presented by the trainees.

(ii) The 86th training course on TB Control of eight weeks duration for DTP key personnel was conducted at the Institute from 16th July - 7th September 2001. In total 57 trainees consisting of 15 Medical Officers and 42 para medicals from different states of the country participated in the training programme. This includes 3 WHO sponsored fellows for 6 weeks duration i.e. two for "Epidemiology & TB

Control" and one for "TB Control & Bacteriology". Apart from this, one Lab Technician from GENETUP, an NGO from Nepal also underwent 8 weeks training in culture, sensitivity and identification tests. The breakup of trainees is given below:
