HIN - WHO Collaborative Project Mobile Data Management System (MDMS)

The design for the data entry collected for the baseline survey to evaluate Mobile data collection among the 16 TB units of Bangalore was finalized. Data entry of the Treatment cards received from 7 TB units of Bangalore were completed. The methodology of the web application development and training of STS/STLS on PDA were finalized in consultation with M/s Analytica. A one week practical training on mobile data management system using simputers was organized for the STS/STLS / Data entry operators and a few key personnel from STDC & 3 RNTCP districts of Bangalore from 25th to 29th October 2004. A total of 45 Participants took part in the training programme.

Journal Custom Contents for Consortia (JCCC)

Meeting was held with M/S informatics Bangalore, India for refining the features of JCCC portal. Mrs. Sudha S Murthy, Sr. Librarian, NTI Visited TRC, Chennai from 13-15th Oct 2004 for conducting Base line survey of JCCC a facility initiated under the HIN project. Data collected were forwarded to the FRCH, Bangalore, the compiler of the report.

Launching of JCCC & MDMS

The simputer assisted MDMS and JCCC – pilot initiatives under WHO sponsored HIN project were launched on 2nd November 2004 by the Principal Secretary, Health & Family Welfare, Government of Karnataka. Other dignitaries were from M/s BEL, M/s Informatics, M/s Analytica, M/s Picopeta Simputers Ltd, Bangalore & TRC, Chennai participated.
