2. Brief Report on HIN Project & Scientific Gallery

a. HIN Activity

Thesaurus on Tuberculosis – A HIN Project outcome

During the process of WHO - HIN Project India – Tuberculosis (TB) to bridge the digital divide between the developing and developed countries in relation to consolidation of publications from the resource Institutions, construction of Thesaurus on Tuberculosis has emerged as an essential end product to include local/specific terminologies on different aspects of TB through which the information can be retrieved. This has become an imminent need for optimum utilization of the research material that were gathered and digitized under the HIN project. Apart from this, these terminologies are not available in the Medical

Subject Headings developed by the National Library of Medicine, Maryland USA that is used as basic tool for assigning Keywords. Therefore the National Tuberculosis Institute, Bangalore, as nodal center took a lead role in construction of Thesaurus on TB based on the terminologies evolved during the process of Information and completed with advise and inputs from Prof. Neelameghan, adviser and consultant of the HIN Project. The Thesaurus brought out as soft copy contains 2910 terms on TB with scope notes, its use as related term, narrow term and broader term. A user manual has also been prepared. Now the distribution of this need to be done.

b. Scientific Gallery:

Software related to the Projection & Information kiosk from M/s Adithya software solution has been received after rectification. The same will be loaded to the systems for checking.

The AMC representative from Pranag Data Links Pvt.Ltd. has created a separate drive in the computer of the projection room and loaded the software for projection. This is to solve the intermittent problems, which were occurring during the projection.

Interchanged the computers of the projection & the Kiosk facility to overcome the intermittent problems occurring during the projection, as these problems are not solved even after creating a separate drive. No problems repeated during the first test run after the interchange.
