External Quality Assessment system, integral part of quality assurance, involve quality assessment methods conducted periodically by a national level laboratory of state level labs & state level labs in turns of peripheral labs with in the smear microscopy laboratory network. The three EQA methods practiced in India are

iii. Random blinded cross-checking (RBRC)

of the routine microscopy slides. The EQA system aims at identifying the systematic error in the laboratory not individual technician's errors in smear microscopy. The outcome of the WEQA activities will assure quality in diagnosis & followup smear examinations such that false positive & false negative in the smear examination are avoided.
